As I reflect on 2025, I am reminded that impact is never measured merely by numbers, milestones, or recognition, but by lives protected, truth restored, and courage awakened.

This past year has been one of profound momentum for Jaco Booyens Ministries. What began decades ago as a mission born out of firsthand exposure to exploitation has continued to mature into a comprehensive movement—one rooted in prevention, survivor advocacy, and systemic reform. In 2025, we did not simply respond to the problem of human trafficking; we confronted the structures that allow it to persist.

Through survivor-informed research, legislative advocacy, and national training efforts, our work expanded beyond awareness into decisive action. We engaged lawmakers, legal experts, educators, faith leaders, and frontline professionals to address one of the most urgent failures in our justice system: the lack of specialized mechanisms to prosecute traffickers and protect victims. Our advancement of a dedicated Human Trafficking Court framework reflects a conviction we hold deeply—that justice must be firm against offenders and unequivocally humane toward survivors.

At the same time, we remained steadfast in what has always mattered most: equipping communities. From trauma-informed curricula and youth recovery initiatives to international partnerships and faith-based training, we worked to ensure that prevention begins long before exploitation takes hold. Our mission remains holistic because the problem is holistic—touching the mind, body, soul, family, and society.

None of this work is possible without the courage of survivors who choose to speak, the dedication of our team, the wisdom of our partners, and the faithfulness of supporters who believe that darkness does not get the final word. I am especially grateful for those who labor quietly, often unseen, yet relentlessly, to protect the vulnerable and restore what has been broken.

As we look ahead, our resolve is clear. We will continue to pursue truth without compromise, justice without fear, and restoration without condition. The work before us is significant, but so is our hope. We believe that change is not only possible—it is already underway. Thank you for standing with us.

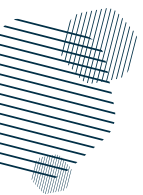

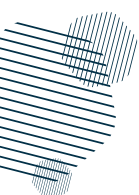

EQUIPPING THE FRONTLINES

SANE NURSE TRAINING

2025

In 2025, Jaco Booyens Ministries provided Spring and Fall semester trainings for **SANE nurses and forensic nursing students**, equipping frontline medical professionals to identify and respond to human trafficking.

Trainings served advanced forensic providers, rural nurses, emergency room nurses, nurse practitioners, and SANE-adult and pediatric trainees, covering trafficking prevalence and risk factors, grooming behaviors, the intersection of trafficking and sexual abuse, and the impact on adult, adolescent, and pediatric patients. Participants were trained to recognize warning signs and take appropriate action when trafficking is suspected, strengthening trauma-informed care and early intervention across healthcare settings. At our SANE Nurse Trainings, we watched hearts awaken and eyes open to the realities of trafficking—right here in our own communities—strengthening trauma-informed care and early intervention where it matters most.

CURRICULUM



In 2025, JBM developed 2 new curricula:

The Way to Freedom is a trauma-informed, faith-based 12-step recovery program designed for youth ages 12–18 struggling with addiction, self-harm, destructive behaviors, or deep emotional wounds.

MELP is a structured Multilingual English Learning Program designed to help learners of all ages build confidence in reading, writing, speaking, and comprehension.



WISE COUNTY PREVENTION VIDEO

In 2025, Jaco Booyens Ministries partnered with the Wise County Sheriff's Office to produce a prevention and awareness video supporting community education and public safety efforts. As Wise County continues to experience rapid population growth, this collaboration helped equip the community with greater awareness around exploitation risks and the importance of early identification and prevention. The video reinforced shared commitments to public trust, accountability, and proactive protection—strengthening the collective effort to safeguard families and vulnerable individuals across the region.

Providing an expert point-of-view on the harms and threats facing our children in person and online.

In 2025, JBM strategically engaged national media platforms to elevate the national conversation around human trafficking and child exploitation. Through these appearances and published opinion pieces, JBM expanded public awareness, strengthened credibility with policymakers and parents, and helped shift the cultural narrative toward prevention, accountability, and systemic reform. Media engagement in 2025 served as a force multiplier, amplifying survivor-informed advocacy, advancing legislative dialogue, and increasing public urgency around protecting children.

This year, JBM launched a social media series **“What Predators Don’t Want You To Know,”** providing education and challenging stereotypes associated with trafficking.



NEW JBM WEBSITE & PARENT COMMUNITY



Developed in 2025 for a 2026 launch!

Jaco Booyens Ministries completed a **full website redesign** of HelpJBM.org, transforming it into a dynamic, interactive platform that equips families with practical tools to protect their children in an increasingly complex digital world. At the heart of this initiative is the JBM Parent Community and Parent Toolkit, a growing network and resource hub designed to serve parents with wisdom, clarity, and faith.

Through guided, short, and practical monthly resources, families are equipped to understand and respond to the real threats facing children today—including grooming, sextortion, pornography, AI exploitation, identity manipulation, online trends, and gaming risks—without fear or overwhelm.

Each month provides a one-page teaching, often-overlooked tech-safety steps, and simple conversation tools that strengthen trust at home and build discernment in children. Notably, JBM developed a dedicated Parent Toolkit for families raising children with special needs, addressing unique vulnerabilities and environments that are often overlooked in child-safety education.

Together, HelpJBM.org, the Parent Toolkit, and the Parent Community empower families across the country to stay informed, proactive, and united—protecting kids, equipping parents, and strengthening families through awareness, preparation, and action.

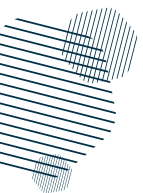

RESCUE - DOMESTIC

Intervention That Saved a Life

In 2025, JBM trained communities across the country to recognize how predators groom children online. That training led to real intervention – including one that saved a life.

It started quietly.

A teenage girl began posting about her sadness on social media. Someone noticed. Messages followed – casual at first, affirming, consistent. Instagram moved to Facebook. Trust was built slowly and intentionally.

All of it unfolded in ordinary places – at home, at youth group, at her grandmother's house. Even with a watchful mother checking device, the trafficker coached her to shift platforms and keep conversations hidden.

Messages became photos. Photos became manipulation. Shame and coercion deepened the control.

Then the escalation.

She shared her home address. Packages arrived, including a burner phone. The reality could no longer be ignored.

Her mother reached out for help.

JBM coordinated intervention and alerted law enforcement after intercepting a final message demanding an in-person meeting. The meeting never happened.

The trafficker remains at large – a sobering reminder that awareness and training are not optional.

The trauma affected the entire family. Restorative care was needed. In faith, the mother made the difficult decision to place her daughter in a specialized program, choosing long-term healing over short-term comfort.

Today, we celebrate.

This courageous teen has graduated and is preparing to return home.

Healing continues.

A childhood is being restored.

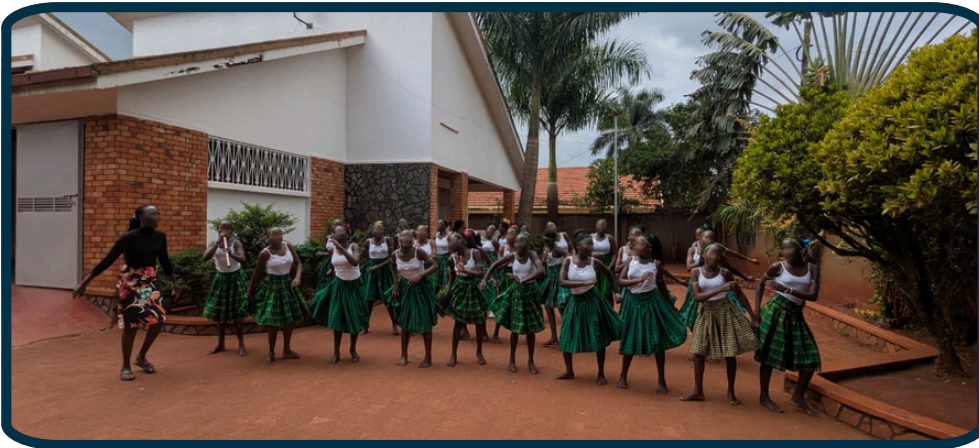
And JBM will walk with this family every step forward.

RESCUE - INTERNATIONAL

International Rescue and Advocacy combating human trafficking through rescue operations and comprehensive rehabilitation.



UGANDA



- ✓ **Rescues:** 27 girls (ages 12–18) freed from trafficking.
- ✓ **Physical Healing:** Medical care provided for severe traumas, including broken hips, STDs, forced abortions, and unplanned pregnancies.
- ✓ **Education:** All girls receive literacy and basic life skills training.
- ✓ **Vocational Training:** Programs underway in tailoring, cooking, and hairdressing to promote economic independence.

In preparation for providing a Christ-centered, safe, trauma-informed facility focused on the individual needs of children and youth recovering from trafficking or abuse and neglect—serving both private and state placements—we have completed the following foundational tasks:



RESTORATION - THE WAY RANCH

- ✓ Launched The Way Ranch Texas website to expand awareness, engagement, and mission visibility.
- ✓ Successfully hosted the inaugural Freedom Classic fundraiser in support of The Way Ranch, Texas.
- ✓ Developed core policies and procedures, ensuring ongoing compliance with licensing and Texas Child Care requirements, including the Policy and Procedure Manual, Parent/Child Handbook, and Staff Manual.
- ✓ Designed Christ-centered care protocols for trafficked individuals, supporting restoration, healing, and a clear pathway toward future independence.
- ✓ Developed a comprehensive staff training curriculum to equip team members for trauma-informed, mission-aligned care.
- ✓ Authored a 12-step addiction and trauma recovery curriculum grounded in biblical principles and trauma-informed best practices.
- ✓ Began building collaborative relationships with professional service providers, including therapists, medical professionals, spiritual leaders, law enforcement, educators, and volunteers.
- ✓ Gathered on The Way Ranch property for a time of prayer and preparation, walking the land, praying over it, and staking* it as an act of faith. We asked God to cleanse, protect, and bless the property, declaring His sovereignty and entrusting the future of The Way Ranch to His purposes. This moment marked an important step in spiritually preparing both the land and our team for the work ahead.

TWR LAND DEVELOPMENT



Land development officially began in 2025 at The Way Ranch, marking a major step toward preparing the property for restoration, training, and long-term mission growth.

Key progress includes:

- ✔ Construction trailer and onsite facilities in place to support ongoing development
- ✔ Extensive site cleanup, including removal of existing barbed-wire fencing, gates, and debris
- ✔ Property beautification, including tree trimming, brush clearing, and mulch chipping
- ✔ Completion of front entrance fencing

Ongoing work includes:

- ✔ Installation of an additional 5,280 feet of perimeter fencing for security
- ✔ Continued maintenance of 75 acres to support safe and effective land use

Looking ahead, a 30-foot cross will be placed between the prayer garden and chapel—serving as a visible symbol of faith and hope at the heart of The Way Ranch.

LEGISLATIVE IMPACT

This year, Jaco Booyens Ministries closely monitored 287 key pieces of legislation that shape the safety and future of America's children. Through persistent advocacy and education, **important bills were passed into law**—strengthening protections against trafficking, grooming, and exploitation.

Our Policy Division also advanced the mission through three major Amicus Briefs—defending Texas's age-verification law in *Free Speech Coalition v. Paxton*, standing for parental rights and education transparency in *Taylor v. Tennessee Department of Education*, and protecting the right of licensed counselors to provide faith-based therapy in *Chiles v. Salazar*.

JBM produced landmark reports that continue to shape national reform: The Immunity Gap Report, Gender Modification Report, and Effects of Pornography Report; along with two technology-focused publications—The Roblox Report and The Apple Accountability Report—which expose gaps in child online safety and corporate responsibility. The year also included a Letter to the Governor of Texas urging stronger enforcement of child protection laws.

Because of your support, JBM is able to educate and provide resources that protects children, defends freedom of faith and family, and restores justice with truth at its foundation.

2025 BILL HIGHLIGHT

HB 4623



HB 4623 is a groundbreaking child protection bill that ends cover-ups in Texas schools. It ensures that when school districts ignore or mishandle reports of staff sexual misconduct, they can be held accountable in court—no more hiding behind immunity.

KEY PROVISIONS:

- ✓ **Ends governmental immunity** when districts fail to act on reports of abuse.
- ✓ **Empowers survivors and families** with the right to sue for inaction or cover-ups.
- ✓ **Stops the use of NDAs and silencing tactics** in abuse cases.
- ✓ **Protects whistleblowers** and mandates reporting safeguards.
- ✓ **Brings public transparency** to how schools handle allegations.



BOTTOM LINE

HB 4623 puts the safety of children above the reputation of institutions. It holds schools accountable—because silence isn't protection. It's complicity.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING COURTS (HTC)

In 2025, Jaco Booyens Ministries led a groundbreaking national initiative urging Congress to establish the first **Specialized Human Trafficking Courts (HTCs)**—a critical reform designed to close longstanding gaps in the prosecution of traffickers and the protection of survivors.

Despite decades of anti-trafficking laws, traffickers are rarely held accountable. Federal prosecutors average fewer than 200 true trafficking cases per year, and state-level conviction rates remain alarmingly low. Extensive research shows that these failures are often driven by a lack of subject-matter expertise within the judiciary to manage the complexity of trafficking cases.

To address this, JBM released a landmark white paper in July 2025—developed with pro bono legal counsel from Akin Gump Strauss Hauer & Feld, LLP—outlining a scalable, cost-effective model for Human Trafficking Courts. These specialized courts would be presided over by trained judges with exclusive jurisdiction over trafficking cases, incorporating trauma-informed practices that prioritize survivor safety while strengthening prosecution outcomes.

The HTC framework has already gained bipartisan support from U.S. Senators, Representatives, prosecutors, academics, investigators, and leading anti-trafficking organizations—marking a significant step toward systemic justice reform.

COMMUNION AMERICA

The "**Communion America**" gathering took place on the National Mall in Washington, D.C., from October 9 to October 12, 2025, featuring 50 tents—one for each U.S. state—hosting nonstop worship, prayer, and gospel proclamation throughout the event. The highlight was a mile-long communion table stretching from the Washington Monument to the U.S. Capitol on October 11, described as the longest communion table in history, symbolizing unity among believers from all 50 states, Puerto Rico, Israel, and various generations.

50 Tents. 50 States. One Table. Millions Reached.

Including a special focus on Gen Z. The event, organized by Awaken the Dawn and Allied Ministries, was framed as a spiritual revival centered on Jesus, with participants engaging in repentance, worship, and a call for national renewal, culminating in a powerful display of faith and intercession.

The gathering coincided with the Jewish Feast of Tabernacles and was preceded by a 40-day period of prayer and fasting, with leaders emphasizing its significance as a fulfillment of Jesus' prayer for unity in John 17.





THE FREEDOM CLASSIC

GOLF TOURNAMENT FUNDRAISER



The Freedom Classic – JBM Golf Day was a sold-out event and a significant moment of impact for JBM. Golfers, sponsors, volunteers, and community partners came together in unity and purpose to advance the fight against sexual exploitation and human trafficking.

This event generated critical financial support for JBM’s core mission areas—rescue, restoration, and prevention—with funds directly benefiting The Way Ranch and survivor stabilization services. The impact of this day extends well beyond the event itself, strengthening long-term efforts to protect and restore vulnerable lives.
